Château Haut-Brion's tasting notes:

AN EXCEPTIONAL YEAR

The wine is hard and tannic, giving it a slight bitter taste. But on the whole it is concentrated, complex, long. The bouquet is very flowery. A wine which needs more time.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures: 3478 °C

Rain: 259 mm

Current vintage notes

The hottest year (after 1976) in a half. century, making up part of the cycle of dry years 1945, '46, '47, '49) which brought swarms of locusts to the Southwest, as far as Bordeaux. During the summer there were 42 days of high heat; water was rationed in the Gironde. Wine of exceptional power.
