AN AVERAGE YEAR

Because of its firmness, this wine was judged harshly in its youth. Today it is marvelous, with great aromatic complexity on the nose and in the mouth. A unique wine with a harmonious make-up. The wine has the characteristics of "Pessac" Graves with smoky and caramelized fruit overtones. A very good bottle considering the year."
