Château Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

A LESSER YEAR

At Haut-Brion, confronted with these difficult conditions, it was decided to proceed with an extremely severe selection of the grapes as they were picked from the vines. The result is a particularly aromatic, fruity, firm and supple wine, well-balanced and mellow in the mouth. Its present state of maturity presages still more development. Haut-Brion '68 is known to be one of the best wines of the vintage.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3102 °C

Rain : 458 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 11

Harvest : from 27/09/1968 to 07/10/1968

Current vintage notes

A late-starting year but with normal heat. Unfortunately, the month of August was very rainy (161 mm.) and September equally so (97 mm.). The grapes were in poor condition long before the harvest. Few good wines were produced in this year.
